Parking

There are 2 Edison Park Fast parking locations within a 10-minute walk of the Law School.

The 15 Worth Street site is an exterior parking lot at the intersection of Worth Street and West Broadway (around \$45 for the day).

The 88 Leonard Street site is an interior garage on Leonard Street between Church Street and Broadway (around \$51 for the day).

Subway

The New York Law School is conveniently located near 2 subway stations on the 7th Avenue line.

1 (local) to Franklin Street. Exit at Varick Street and West Broadway. Walk one block south on West Broadway. The School is located on West Broadway between Worth and Leonard Streets.

2, 3 (express) to Chambers Street. Exit at West Broadway and walk four blocks north on West Broadway.

Cancellations
